In 2024, the Friends:

- Celebrated its 40th Anniversary of incorporation with a gala and “Tops of the Rockies” at the Grand Lake Yacht Club. The event was enjoyed by more than 100 people with great food, beverages, music and auctions. Financial results of Tops will be shared at the meeting.
- Provided \$21,350 to the GCLD for the 2024 Summer Reading Program. This brings our two year financial contribution to GCLD to \$44,450, which funds special programming for children and teens.
- Held monthly, genre specific book sales at the branches; special book sales including Granby Fourth of July and Grand Lake Buffalo Days which generated more than \$3,250 and continued to list books for sale on eBay. You can find us on eBay at: Friends of the Grand County Library Inc.
- Held the Friends Pancake Breakfast and Bake Sale during June’s Kremmling Days, which generated \$1,660.
